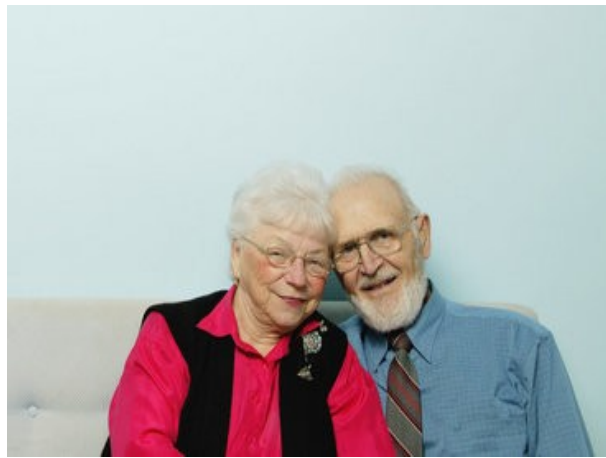


***Have you had an Emergency Department visit in the last 3 months?
